RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNING BODY OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSHONE INDIANS OF NEVADA

RESOLUTION NO: 12-TM-13

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE TRIBAL COUNCIL OF THE TE-MOAK TRIBE OF WESTERN SHOSONE INDIANS OF NEVADA, THAT:

WHEREAS, this organization is a recognized Indian organization as defined under the Indian Reorganization Act of 1934, as amended, and exercises rights of home rule and is responsible for the promotion of the economic, health and welfare of its members; and

WHEREAS, the authority contained in Public Law 93-638, as amended (Indian Self-Determination and Education Assistance Act), provides Indian Tribes and organizations to plan, organize and implement its own social and economic programs; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe provides for the self-determination and the general welfare and well-being of all tribal members and maintains a certified system of records and administration of federal funds which is distributed to the constituent bands; and

WHEREAS, the Te-Moak Tribe has a trust responsibility that includes sovereignty of each constituent bands and its self-determination; and

WHEREAS, the existing Contract Scope of Work for the Te-Moak Judicial Services has not changed; and

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Te-Moak Tribal Council is requesting the Bureau of Indian Affairs to extend the existing contract of the Te-Moak Judicial Services Program for an additional two (2) years commencing October 1, 2012 to September 30, 2014, a term of two (2) years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chairperson or Vice Chairperson of the Te-Moak Tribal Council shall be authorized to affix his signature and to negotiate and execute any and all necessary documents for said extension.
